<b>CHAMPAGNE</b>			
<b>BRUT</b>			
<b>Deutz, Brut Classic</b>	NV	75	360
<i>On the nose are mellow and reminiscent of acacia flowers, confectionery, Reinettes apples, and brioche. Medium to full-bodied and fleshy but precise, it's elegant and charming, with a seamless profile and considerable immediate appeal.</i>			
<b>Billecart-Salmon, Brut Rosé</b>	NV	93	450
<i>Lacy in texture, with sleek acidity, this well-knit rosé Champagne offers delicate notes of blood orange glacé, pickled ginger and oyster shell, revealing a rich hint of grilled nut. The firm, almost crunchy finish is nicely spiced and lingering.</i>			
<b>SPARKLING</b>			
<b>Bolla, Prosecco di Conegliano Valdobbiadene Superiore, Brut, Italy</b>	NV	41	190
<i>The grapes for Prosecco are harvested early, preserving their natural acidity in this crisp, sparkling wine. It has a pale straw colour with clean aromas of lemon, apple and a hint of peach. Very refreshing in the palate.</i>			
<b>ROSÉ</b>			
<b>Domaines Ott, Château de Selle, Côtes de Provence, France</b>	2018	59	280
<i>Displaying an array of red berry and citrus fruit aromas and a sexy floral nuance. Dry, stony and precise on the palate, offering sappy orange and redcurrant flavours that flesh out slowly with air. Finishing with outstanding clarity.</i>			
<b>WHITE</b>			
<b>Rimapere, Marlborough, Single Vineyard, Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand</b>	2021	47	220
<i>A joint venture between Baron Edmond de Rothschild and Terry Peabody of Craggy Range. Very defined Sauvignon with tremendous concentration. It delivers pronounced aromatics of lemon peel, sage, ripe lemon, passion fruit, grapefruit, pine needles and steely minerality.</i>			
<b>Ansgar Clüsserath, Steinreich, Trocken, Riesling, Germany</b>	2016	39	180
<i>Elegant bouquet of ripe, bright fruits with stone and lemon flavours. Medium-bodied, dry and piquant, with refreshing lemon and white stone fruit aromas, great elegance, and lingering salinity and tension.</i>			
<b>Misha's Vineyard, Central Otago, The Gallery, Gewürztraminer, New Zealand</b>	2016	51	240
<i>Classic varietal aromas of rose petal, lychee, ginger and cinnamon, this off-dry style has a gentle but full palate that balances sweet baked fruits with fresh ripe citrus.</i>			
<b>Sidewood, Adelaide Hills, Marringa Chardonnay, Australia</b>	2019	53	250
<i>This luscious and opulent wine displays great length and fruit flavour intensity of lemon and lime citrus, honeydew melons with hints of nutmeg spice. Long and delicious with a wonderful line of acid, balanced by an incredible softness.</i>

<b>Bourgogne, Laforêt Pinot Noir, Maison Joseph Drouhin, France</b>	2016	57	270
<i>Great finesse with silky tannins and beautiful harmony with the oak. Developing nicely and really a lovely wine; dark fruit, game and sauvage, crushed stone, damp leaf litter; the palate is beautifully balanced.</i>			
<b>Dolcetto d'Alba, Cordero di Montezemolo, Italy</b>	2020	55	260
<i>This pure, picture-book Dolcetto is presented in a brick red. The youthful red wine, which deliberately dispensed with long wood storage, reveals a bouquet of herbal and cinnamon aromas. On the palate, it captivates with its lively fruit with distinct cherry and lilacberry nuances.</i>			
<b>Chinon, Francs de Pieds, Château de Coulaine, France</b>	2015	43	200
<i>Given the purest expression of Cabernet Franc that one is likely to find in the Loire. Beautifully elegant and fresh with vivid raspberry perfume and intense yet fresh dark berry and spice on palate.</i>			
<b>Salomon Estate, Fleurieu Peninsula, Finnis River, Shiraz, Australia</b>	2013	49	230
<i>A cuvée in the tradition of the northern Rhone Côte-Rôtie region. A deep ruby hue with a bouquet of floral tones, dark berries, tobacco, and soft leather. A lush fruitiness on the palette, with well-meshed tannins. A wine with depth and the utmost elegance, finely fruity and complex in finish..</i>			
<b>DESSERT</b>			
<b>Wittmann, Rheinhessen, Auslese, Riesling, Germany</b>	2015	30	75ml
<i>In the nose a lot of sweet fruit, such as citrus fruit and dried yellow fruit. On palate the beautiful game between sweet and sour. The wine remains drinkable despite its concentration. Long aftertaste there is also a sublime mineral touch.</i>
