<b>CHAMPAGNE</b>			
<b>BRUT</b>			
<b>Taittinger Brut Réserve</b>	NV	81	390
<i>The nose, very open and expressive, delivers aromas of fruit and brioche. It also gives off the fragrance of peach, white flowers (hawthorn, acacia) and vanilla pod. The entry onto the palate is lively, fresh and in total harmony.</i>			
<b>SPARKLING</b>			
<b>Santa Margherita, Prosecco Superiore Di Valdobbiadene, Brut, Italy</b>	NV	43	200
<i>Clean, pleasantly fruity bouquet, reminiscent of rennet apples and peach blossom. Its flavor is rounded and well-balanced. It has a very fine, persistent bead and scents of apples and pears that act as a prelude to the flavors of ripe stone fruit with a bit of melon and orange. Fresh and lively with a long, dry, yeasty finish.</i>			
<b>ROSÉ</b>			
<b>Fleurs de Prairie, Côtes de Provence, France</b>	2021	41	190
<i>Translates as wildflowers, bright and crisp rosé with flavors of red fruit, lemon, and a subtle note of tropical fruits on the finish. Delicate flavors of red fruit and lemon, and a subtle note of tropical fruits on the finish. Its bright, refreshing acidity.</i>			
<b>WHITE</b>			
<b>Greywacke, Marlborough, Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand</b>	2022	69	330
<i>Aromas of cassis and passionfruit are first to emerge, with guava, crisp pear and white peach adding a delicious fruit salad intricacy. On the palate, it's generous yet refreshing, with ripe pineapple and a lime sherbet zing, layered with elderflower and hints of citrus blossom. A classic example of Greywacke's interpretation of the famous Marlborough style</i>			
<b>Sherwood, Waipara, Stratum, Riesling, Australia</b>	2014	39	170
<i>Full flavoured with elegant lemon, lime and red apple aromas. The palate is juicy and bright with hints of spice, florals and Turkish Delight flavours. A medium-dry Riesling with a slight sweetness and long finish.</i>			
<b>Gavi, Principessa Gavia, Banfi, Italy</b>	2020	49	230
<i>Pale yellow color with shades of green. The perfume of boxwood combines with the flower notes of jasmine and the fruity aromas of melon and white peach. On the palate, the wine's pleasant sapidity supports its eminent drinkability.</i>			
<b>Chablis, 1ér Cru Montmains, Olivier Tricon, France</b>	2019	77	370
<i>Initially soft in mouth and continues to soften thanks to the magnitude of this wine. Light aromas vaunting dried and ripe fruits. Its gold yellow, its surprising concentration and its richness turn it into an elegant wine.</i>

<b>RED</b>			
<b>Sancerre Rouge, Domaine De La Perrière, France</b>	2020	59	280
<i>Similar to Burgundy Pinot Noir de Nuits they need a bit more air to disclose their best virtues. Ruby colour with a fragrant bouquet reminiscent of cherry, strawberry, plum, rhubarb with gentle notes of vanilla, oak, violet, pepper, slightly earthy with a whiff of licorice. Medium-bodied with soft medium acidity, smooth mild dry tannins. Flavours of red fruit with spices making a long finish.</i>			
<b>Château Lilian Ladouys, St Estèphe, Bordeaux, France</b>	2017	77	370
<i>Has a fragrant herbal waft on the nose with a core of baked red and black currants, Morello cherries, tilled earth and cedar chest. The palate is medium-bodied, delicately played and pleasantly chewy with plenty of freshness and lovely purity on the finish.</i>			
<b>J. Lohr, Cypress Vineyards, California, Zinfandel, USA</b>	2018	35	160
<i>Has a medium-dark color with a youthful purple hue. Black cherry, cola nut and brambly aromas turn to notes of cranberry and pomegranate on the palate. This wine delivers intense red fruit flavors with a soft, bright finish.</i>			
<b>Silk and Spice, Portugal</b>	2020	51	240
<i>Blend of Touriga Nacional, Baga, Alicante Bouchet &amp; Syrah. The grapes selected come from the regions Dão, Bairrada, and Lisboa, and are vinified separately. Characterized by intense aromas of ripe red and black fruit, such as blackberries and ripe plum. A spicy character evokes vanilla, black pepper and pink peppercorn, combined with hints of mocha. It is full-bodied with a balanced taste, very soft tannins and a long and balanced finish. Celebrating the Portuguese explorers of the East Indies in the Age of Discovery.</i>			
<b>DESSERT</b>			
<b>Rolf Binder, Barossa Valley, Late Harvest Riesling, Australia</b>	2012	75ml 30	
<i>Pure, fresh floral nose with lavender and lime blossom; no botrytis influence in the aromatics. The sweet silky palate shows a little exotic botrytis fruit but pithy lime and green apple dominate and combine with zesty acidity to leave an overall impression of fresh fruit.</i>
